General Convention Information

STAGE

•All contestants will enter and exit the stage from the same side, Stage Right.

•No front curtain will be used during quartet or chorus competition.

RISER CONFIGURATION

We will be using the Alternate Riser configuration.

PHOTOGRAPHY

•Quartet pictures will be taken in the traffic pattern. Chorus pictures will be taken on stage.

•Plan your pose in advance.

•The photo order forms are also available online at www.readphotography.com

•Turn your photo order in at Friday a.m. briefing. Please put order forms with payment in an envelope with your chorus or quartet name on the envelope.

MIDSIDE AND SMALL CHORUS AWARD ELIGIBILITY

The number for determining eligibility for these awards includes all singing members on stage at any given time, but does not include the director(s). The number turned in at the directors' briefing is the final number used by the panel secretary when determining which choruses meet the midsize and small size category criteria. To be eligible for these awards (in their category), they must attain 400 points or above.

A small chorus is classified as Division A with a minimum of 15 singing members and a maximum of 30 singing members on stage.

A midsize chorus is classified as Division AA with a minimum of 31 singing members and a maximum of 60 singing members on stage.

CHAPTER-AT-LARGE MEMBERS

Four chapter-at-large members may form a quartet and compete at regional competition.

SCORING

In the event of a tie in the total score between 2 or more contestants, the contestant receiving the highest total score in the SOUND category is awarded the higher placement. Remember, winners of all awards must score 400 points or above.

WITHDRAWAL

If a chorus or quartet has to withdraw from contest, a written withdrawal notice must be received at International Headquarters. A phone call is not sufficient.





Open Division Information

Open Division is open to choruses and quartets.

 There is not a different registration fee for the Open Division. All competition registration fees are the same (chorus: \$150; quartet: \$100).

Competitors have 10 minutes to complete their Open Division packages.

Competing in the Open Division meets the 3-year competition requirement for choruses.

Riser configurations will not change due to Open Division. There will still be either standard or alternate.

It is the region's choice to allow both riser configurations; it is also their choice to decide which configuration is offered first.

The drawing for regional competitions will be as follows:

o Quartets: Evaluation Only, International Division, Open Division

o Choruses:

One riser configuration: Evaluation Only, International Division, Open Division

 Directors with dual memberships who sing and direct two different choruses in the same contest will be taken into consideration for the order of appearance draws.

Timing starts at the first word spoken or sung. Excessive time spent entering the stage can result in a delay of contest penalty.

Competitors will use the same lighting and staging options that are available to the International Division competitors, i.e. no
pyro techniques or electricity will be allowed on stage.

Competitors may not change from International Division to Open Division (or vice versa) after the first draw for order of appearance has been conducted at HQ.

Competitors wishing to qualify for Harmony Classic or International Competition must compete in the International Division.
 Competitors cannot qualify for Harmony Classic or International if they compete in Open Division.

Competitors cannot enter both the International Division and the Open Division of the same contest.

 The same song choice limitations apply to the contest songs as there have always been: no patriotic, religious or Sweet Adelines International songs may be sung as contest songs.

Open Division provides competitors with the opportunity to present a "show performance" that is enhanced by the educa-

tional experience gained through official scoresheets. It is for evaluation only and thus receives a letter score. • If a competitor is disgualified from the Open Division, they are not eligible for the Audience Choice Award.

 Only competitors optaring the Open Division gualify for the Audience Choice Award

Only competitors entering the Open Division qualify for the Audience Choice Award.

 Competitors competing at International in the current year and performing in Open Division are not eligible for the Audience Choice Award.

 If there is only one quartet or chorus competing in the Open Division, they will receive a Bravo Award. Audience Choice Award will only be awarded if there is 2 or more competitors in the Open Division.

Note: Open Division competitors will be in the random draw with International Division competitors. Evaluation Only competitors will still compete first in their respective riser configurations. If competing in the open Division, quartets and choruses must complete the cue forms (examples on page 23 (chorus) and page 24 (quartets) from the International e-packet and send or email to Lyla Larson NO LATER than April 1, 2020




